#### Notes to the Accounts

- 1 Bank fees includes admin fees charged by SIL (Societe Internationale Linguistique) in Cameroon who receive gifts and convert monies to cfas for WFC
- 2 visa costs and health insurance cover Project Manager for visits to Cameroon
- 3 Staff expenses in Cameroon are for part-time Health Promoters who train villagers in use of water filters and basic hygiene
- 4 WFC covers the travel and accommodaton expenses in Cameroon for the Project Manager
- 5 WFC operates a Misubishi Pajero for team travel in the Ndop region
- 6 Double deduction error in March 2013 of €2395.73 has been adjusted in this figure
- 7 Pastor Edward handled payments to the Health Promoters and filter contractors in the absence of the Project Manager till end Sept 2013.
- 8 Expenses incurred by Project Manager and pending refund
- 9 cfas = Cameroonian Francs
- 10 Expenses were increased during 2014 because the Irish Program Manager made two vists compared to one in 2013.
- 11 Our partner Water For Cameroon Ngoketunjia was registered in Cameroon in 2014 and opened a bank account there, which will be used for transfer of funds.
