#### **Water For Cameroon Finance Report**

#### Year ended 31 December 2018

#### **Notes to the Accounts**

- 1 In 2018, WfC Ireland partnered with Rotary clubs in Canada and Kumbo in Cameroon.
- 2 Our partner Water For Cameroon Ngoketunjia (WFCN) reimbursed WFCI for the cost of 2 pumps for wells, from monies provided for this purpose by Kumbo Rotary.
  - The amounts on the expenditure page for well digging, filter making and health prmotion show the amount spent directly by WFC Ireland and does not include any expenditure by WFCN in these areas.
- 3 WfC Ireland covered the travel, accommodation and project expenses in Cameroon for the Project Manager -2 visits were made in 2017 and 1 in 2018.
- 4 Rent was paid for a secure space in Ndop to store supplies, with a small salary to the shop manager. This figure also includes payment to a Cameroonian consultant for a project survey and the cost of skype phone calls between Ireland and Cameroon
- 5 Reconciliation of advances to Project Manager and expenditure incurred by him.
